

astronaut	a person who is trained to travel in a spacecraft
moon	the round object that shines in the sky at night and moves around the Earth
space craft	transport which travels into space
historical sources	something that tells us about the past, e.g. a newspaper, a photograph
International Space Station	The ISS is a large spacecraft in orbit around Earth.
orbit	the circular journey that a spacecraft or planet makes around the sun, the moon, or another planet
timeline	a line that shows the time and the order in which events have happened
