Key Facts:

- **Human features** of St John's are canal, shops, houses, offices and it is a **village**.
- **Physical features** of St John's are vegetation, forest, field, the weather, the seasons.
- A map is a representation of an area showing **human** and **physical features**.
- The UK is made up of England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland.
- The capital **cities** of the UK are London, Cardiff, Edinburgh and Belfast.
- The seas around the UK are the North sea, the Irish sea, the English Channel and the Atlantic Ocean.
- Woking is a **town**.
- The Basingstoke Canal runs through St John's and Woking.



Vocabulary:

house, office, shop, field, forest, vegetation, soil, canal, season, weather	
aerial photograph	A photograph taken from above – it's a bird's eye view.
city	A city is a large town.
country	An area of land that is controlled by its own government.
environment	The place in which a person lives or works.
human feature	Something that is built by humans and does not exist naturally.
landmark	Something that is easy to see and can help a person find the way to a place near it.
map key	Gives you the information needed for the map to make sense and 'unlocks' it. The key explains what the symbols on the map mean.
physical feature	Something that occurs naturally.
town	A large group of houses, shops and factories where people live. They are smaller than cities, but larger than villages.
village	A small group of houses, perhaps with a few shops, that are often in the countryside.
