Topic: 'It's a jungle out there!' - Geography

This **Geography** unit is very exciting as we explore the location of the rainforests of the world and their climate. We shall study the Amazon rainforest in depth and find out why the rainforest is so important. We will look and the animals, plants and people and explore and debate how the rainforest is under threat.

Our **Science** work this term links into the rainforest. We will be studying life cycles of mammals, amphibians, insects, birds and plants. We will also study habitats and adaptations.

In **Art** we will be working on our drawing and painting techniques, with a focus on light and shade. We will look at the works of different artists, to inspire our creations.

Music will focus on listening skills as well as composing using the xylophones and other percussion instruments.

Close to Christmas, our **RE** will focus on light, in religious contexts.
