The big idea

Years 1 and 2 will be looking at different pioneers from history and consider how they have changed how we live now

In History we will:

- Look at different famous figures from history such as Jane Goodall, David Attenborough,
 Tim Peak and Amelia Earhart
- Build up a timeline of famous figures to consider when in history different pioneers lived
- Compare the lives of people in history to our own lives.

In English we will:

- Read and respond to 'Fantastically Great Women who Changed the World" and will write biographies about Amelia Earhart
- Read and respond to "The Great Explorer".

In Geography we will

- Continue to develop our mapping skills and find different places in the world using maps.
- Find places with different climates, including where Jane Goodall studied and places that David Attenborough has visited

In Art we will:

 Paint inspired by the dark, looking at Vincent Van Gogh's art

In Science we will:

- Year 1 will be learning about seasonal changes, animals and caring for the planet
- Year 2 will be learning about plants, and living things and their habitats
