Key learning (Autumn 1)

This half term we will be focusing on the Three Little Pig's fairytale, looking at wheel and axles on transport and comparing St Johns with Japan.

Key Learning (Autumn 2)

This half term we will be focusing on the beauty of flowers, the Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark and Historical events such as Remembrance Day and the Gunpowder Plot.

As **readers** we will:

- Read *Amazing Grace* by Mary Hoffman and *The Owl Who Was Afraid of the Dark* by Jill Thomlinson to continue to practise our reading fluency and skills: vocabulary, inference, prediction, explain, retrieval and summarise.

As **writers** we will write:

- Narrative traditional tales
- Instruction texts (non-fiction)
- Non – chronological reports

As **geographers** we will learn:

- What physical and human features are
- Locating Japan
- What St Johns is like and how we can tell from a map (fieldwork and enquiry)
- What the difference is between the human and physical features of Japan and Woking.

As **historians** we will:

- Understand what happened on the 5th November
- Understand who was involved in the Gunpowder Plot
- Know why the Gunpowder Plot happened
- Know why we celebrate Remembrance Day

As **scientists** we will learn:

- Observe how plants grow
- Plan what seeds we can grow
- About parts of the plant
- About how plants form from seed
- Living things and their habitats

As **mathematicians** we will learn:

- Place value (numbers to 100)
- Addition and subtraction
- Measurement: Money
- Multiplication and division

We will also learn **Art** (the beauty of flowers and sculpture), **DT** (wheel and axles), **RE** (Christianity: What is God like? Why is giving so important), **PSHE**, **Music**, **Computing** (Esafety part 1, coding) and **PE**.

How you can help at home:

- Make sure your child reads aloud to you daily and that you record it in their reading record (5 times a week).
- Make sure your child is getting good night's sleep.
- Use 1 minute maths app for free to practice maths.
- Use workbooks on Whiterose maths parents section to practice maths concepts.
- Ensure earrings are out and hair is tied up on PE days.
- Label children's clothes.
- Send reading records in every day.
